Matthew 13: ⁵³ Now it came to pass, when Jesus had finished these parables, that He departed from there. ⁵⁴ When He had come to His own country, He taught them in their synagogue, so that they were astonished and said, "Where did this *Man* get this wisdom and *these* mighty works? ⁵⁵ Is this not the carpenter's son? Is not His mother called Mary? And His brothers James, Joses, Simon, and Judas? ⁵⁶ And His sisters, are they not all with us? Where then did this *Man* get all these things?" ⁵⁷ So they were offended at Him. But Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his own country and in his own house." ⁵⁸ Now He did not do many mighty works there because of their unbelief.

<u>Sunday:</u> What is a synagogue? Where would they be located? Ask the Lord to send to Birmingham (Hoover, Ala.) RPC those from the metropolitan area who seek simple, scripturally regulated worship to join with them. **Pray** for the ministry of the Covenanter Bookshop in Northern Ireland. **Pray** for Selma (Ala.) RPC, as it wrestles with whether and how to rebuild the church building that was destroyed by a tornado.

Monday: Where was Jesus' country? <u>Saturday:</u> Do you think that our lack of faith may be a factor as to whether Jesus might or might not do mighty works today? Give thanks that Bloomington, Ind., RPC sent a mission team to Ballyclabber RPC in Northern Ireland; pray for lasting fruit, both in the team and in the Ballyclabber congregation. Pray for the service at Atlanta RPC tomorrow, that visitors would be present.
