The Main Point: The living God is the only being worthy of worship.

- We are all interpreters
 - $_{\circ}$ We interpret our experiences because we crave meaning.
 - Our hermeneutic for interpreting life is governed by our frameworks.
 - Without revelation, our interpretations are often wrong, and our ultimate interpretations are always wrong.

INTERPRETING GOD

- We are all worshippers
 - Creaturely worship is inevitable—everyone worships something.
 - o There are no worship-neutral frameworks or worldviews.
 - o While worship is inevitable, right worship is not.
 - o All worship—true and false—motivates action and response.
- We are all accountable
 - $_{\odot}$ God has revealed himself to all truly, but not identically.
 - o Revelation entails responsibility.
 - o No one is only generically accountable.
