**Deuteronomy 15:7** If there be among you a poor man of one of thy brethren within any of thy gates in thy land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not **harden thine heart, nor shut thine hand** from thy poor brother:

**8** But thou **shalt open thine hand wide** unto him, and shalt surely lend him sufficient for his need, in that which he wanteth.

**Proverbs 14:21 He that  
despiseth his neighbour  
sinneth: but he that hath  
mercy on the poor, happy is  
he.**

**Psalm 41:1 Blessed is he that  
considereth the poor: the  
LORD will deliver him in  
time of trouble.**

**2 Corinthians 9:6 But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully.**

**8 And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work:**

**Proverbs 19:17 He that hath  
pity upon the poor lendeth  
unto the LORD; and that  
which he hath given will he  
pay him again.**

**Proverbs 21:13 Whoso stoppeth  
his ears at the cry of the poor,  
he also shall cry himself, but  
shall not be heard.**

**Proverbs 28:27 He that  
giveth unto the poor shall not  
lack: but he that hideth his  
eyes shall have many a curse.**



**Job 29:16 I was a father to the poor: and the cause which I knew not I searched out.**

**17 And I brake the jaws of the wicked, and plucked the spoil out of his teeth.**

**22 After my words they spake not again; and my speech dropped upon them.**

**23 And they waited for me as for the rain; and they opened their mouth wide as for the latter rain.**

**Psalms 119:131** **I opened  
my mouth,** and panted:  
for I longed for thy  
commandments.

**Psalms 35:1 Plead my cause, O LORD, with them that strive with me: fight against them that fight against me.**

**11 False witnesses did rise up; they laid to my charge things that I knew not.**

**12 They rewarded me evil for good to the spoiling of my soul.**

**15 But in mine adversity they rejoiced, and gathered themselves together...**

**21 Yea, they **opened their mouth wide** against me, and said, Aha, aha, our eye hath seen it.**

**26 Let them be ashamed and brought to confusion together that rejoice at mine hurt...**

**Psalms 109:2 For the mouth of

the deceitful **are opened** against  
me: they have spoken against  
me with a lying tongue.**

**Proverbs 13:3 He that keepeth

shall have destruction.**

**Proverbs 21:9 It is better to dwell in a corner of the housetop, than with a brawling woman in a wide house.**

**Proverbs 30:21 For three things the earth is disquieted, and for four which it cannot bear:**

**22 For a servant when he reigneth;  
and a fool when he is filled with meat;**

**23 For an odious woman when she is married...**

3 Which we have heard and known, and

**4 We will not hide them from their children,  
shewing to the generation to come the  
praises of the LORD, and his strength, and  
his wonderful works that he hath done.**

**Proverbs 31:8 Open thy mouth for  
the dumb in the cause of all such  
as are appointed to destruction.**

**9 Open thy mouth, judge  
righteously, and plead the cause of  
the poor and needy.**

**Proverbs 24:7 Wisdom is  
too high for a fool: he  
openeth not his mouth in  
the gate.**

**Proverbs 31:10 Who can find a virtuous woman? for her price is far above rubies.**

**11 The heart of her husband doth safely trust in her, so that he shall have no need of spoil.**

**12 She will do him good and not evil all the days of her life.**

**29 Many daughters have done virtuously, but thou excellest them all.**

Proverbs 31:26 She
